

Spendor A5

IT WAS JUST last month that we first saw these new Spendor A5s, and although we immediately knew they were accomplished speakers, it's taken the increased depth of comparison of this *Group Test* to fully appreciate the extent of their success – these are astoundingly good floorstanders.

Even next to the other small speakers here, the A5s are exceptionally compact, measuring just 79cm in height. They're also very solidly put together, and the four real-wood finishes look very smart.

If you're concerned that the stumpy nature of the A5s might result in a short or small-scale presentation, you can banish the thought. Play *Time to Get Out* from the *Quantum of Solace* soundtrack and it becomes immediately apparent the Spendors can produce a sound that fills the room from floor to ceiling, rendering their diminutive size a sonic irrelevance. The width and space afforded the performance is also

impressive. This is a big soundstage that lends itself well to orchestral scores and big rock pieces.

Importantly, dimension-defying scale isn't their only impressive feature. Not for the first time in this test we spin-up Tori Amos' *Cornflake Girl*, and the Spendors provide the most faithful rendition of it yet. The treble is sparkly and sweet, midrange is multi-layered and textured, and when both the piano and bass guitar hit their lowest notes, the Spendors are able to reveal the key and string independently, where some speakers mix the two together.

All-round brilliance shines through

From the deepest bass to the highest treble there's an admirable tightness, punch and attack. Notes begin and end with superb precision, and that accuracy translates into excitement right through the frequency range. Throw awesome dynamics into the mix, both small-scale and large, and you have a delivery that's as well suited to the London Philharmonic Orchestra as it is to Adele's acoustic pop.

Unlike the other five-star speakers here, the Spendors have no fly in the ointment. They combine scale that's very close to the Dynaudios, with clarity and organisation that can match the PMCs. You get the best of both worlds with these floorstanders, and we're all for that.

BRITISH SPEAKER company Spendor is looking to build on the acclaimed SA1 standmounter with two new floorstanding models, the A5 and A6. Their drive units are based on technology developed for the SA1, and the company says the speakers deliver

a “clear and natural mid-range and beautifully open treble”.

The A5 speakers, which sell for £1495 a pair, stand 79cm tall and use a pair of 15cm drivers, while the larger A6 design, at 88cm tall, uses a single 18cm driver and a 29mm tweeter. Both sets of speakers appear in this issue of the magazine, and with each on the receiving end of five-star reviews, we suggest you check them out.

THIS TEST SERVES to highlight the superb quality available from floorstanding stereo speakers, with half the entrants receiving a coveted five-star verdict, and none dipping below four stars.

The Auroasals are the odd ones out here, but although their crossover-free design won't suit everyone's taste and circumstances, for others they will be exactly what they've been looking for.

The other two four-star speakers are also excellent: the Neats are charming, with a unique style and excellent detail, while the big Dalis have exceptional scale and authority at a very attractive price. Just make sure you've got enough room for them to work at their best.

Star performers battle it out

When it comes to the five-star entrants, the PMCs offer one of the most clean and well-organised soundstages that you're ever likely to hear. The Dynaudios don't quite match them in this regard, but they have greater weight and scale.

Each is the best in its particular speciality, but it's the Spendors that just nose ahead of the pack.

The A5s get very close to the clarity of the PMCs, and equally near to the scale of the Dynaudios, and it's this all-round performance, contained within an unfeasibly compact cabinet, that sees them take first place.
